| Adults – 18 years old and no longer in High School | May Serve All Levels (Grades K-8) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • On-site Activities (OSAs) • D.E.A.R. Buddy • Field Day • Field Trips - Must pay their own fee. Adults and High School students rising 10th grade and older may ride the bus if there is room. • Finale • Jubilee • Parent Meetings • Scholastic Book Fair • Site Set Up and Clean Up • Fall Freedom Fest |
| High School Students – Rising 10 th , 11 th and 12 th Grade | May Serve <u>Level I and II</u> Scholars Only (Grades K-5) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Same activities as adult • Cannot serve Level III |
| Rising 9th Grade, Middle School | <p><i>Must be accompanied by Parent, who must serve as the primary volunteer (with the student acting as a helper).</i></p> May Serve <u>Level I</u> Scholars Only (Grade K-2) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Same activities as adult • Field Trips – Student must pay their own fee and cannot ride the bus. |
| Junior Servant Leader Interns <i>Former scholar who is a graduate of Freedom School Partners.</i> | May Serve Level I and II Scholars Only (Grades K-5) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All site activities, including IRC. • Serves all day during the six-weeks of Freedom School • Recruited and placed by FSP Program Coordinator |
| Bank of America Interns | Bank of America's eight week summer internship program. Primarily serve at the FSP Headquarters. May be assigned to sites for events, evaluations and general assistance. Recruited and placed by Freedom School Staff. |
| Mayor's Youth | Teens selected by the Mayor's Youth Alliance, serving three days for seven weeks at assigned sites. Recruited and placed by FSP Program Coordinator. |
| Site Teen Boards | Level I and II Only (Grades K-5) Teen board members serve two or three weeks in the summer, as well as year round involvement. The site's Teen Board Coordinator recruits and manages these teen. |

Note: Volunteers are not needed during Integrated Reading Curriculum Time (IRC) from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. This is crucial time for our interns and scholars to focus on the curriculum, team building and classroom cohesiveness.
