Development Updates

Individual Giving

- Individual Giving stands at \$133,530 YTD. Current pledges total \$93,560. Cash and pledges total \$227,090.
- Spring Appeal has dropped with a goal of \$40,000 and 515 pieces distributed. Thank you to board members for helping with handwritten notes.
- Burch Mixon Fund currently at \$50,320.
- Board members are encouraged to connect individuals and corporate partners with FSP staff to participate in the summer program.
- Dev. Committee requests board support in securing location for fall Scholar Society reception.

Corporate

- Invited to submit request for renewed support from the Albemarle Foundation. Amount range unspecified. Request has been complete and FSP will hear back by the end of May.
- Final Spring into Summer sponsorship total was \$178,500. This was a \$13,000 increase over last year. Total attendance was approximately 115.
- FSP has received final golf tournament payment. After expenses, total financial contribution of \$113,000.
- Received \$50,000 from Brighthouse Financial.
- Duke Energy confirmed renewed support at \$15,000.
- Novant Health confirmed renewed support at \$10,000.
- Expect to hear from Ally, Bank of America and Truist in the next month.

Foundations

- Confirmed \$100,000 outright support from Levine Foundation. FSP will receive funds by end of May.
- Received \$55,000 from Triad Foundation.
- FSP will submit a grant request to Yield Giving (Mackenzie Scott) Open Call in June.
- Expect to hear from Provident Benevolent Foundation in May.

Government

- FSP approved for \$298,000 in support from NC Department of Public Instruction Summer Mini-Grant program. Funds are received as reimbursements over the summer.
