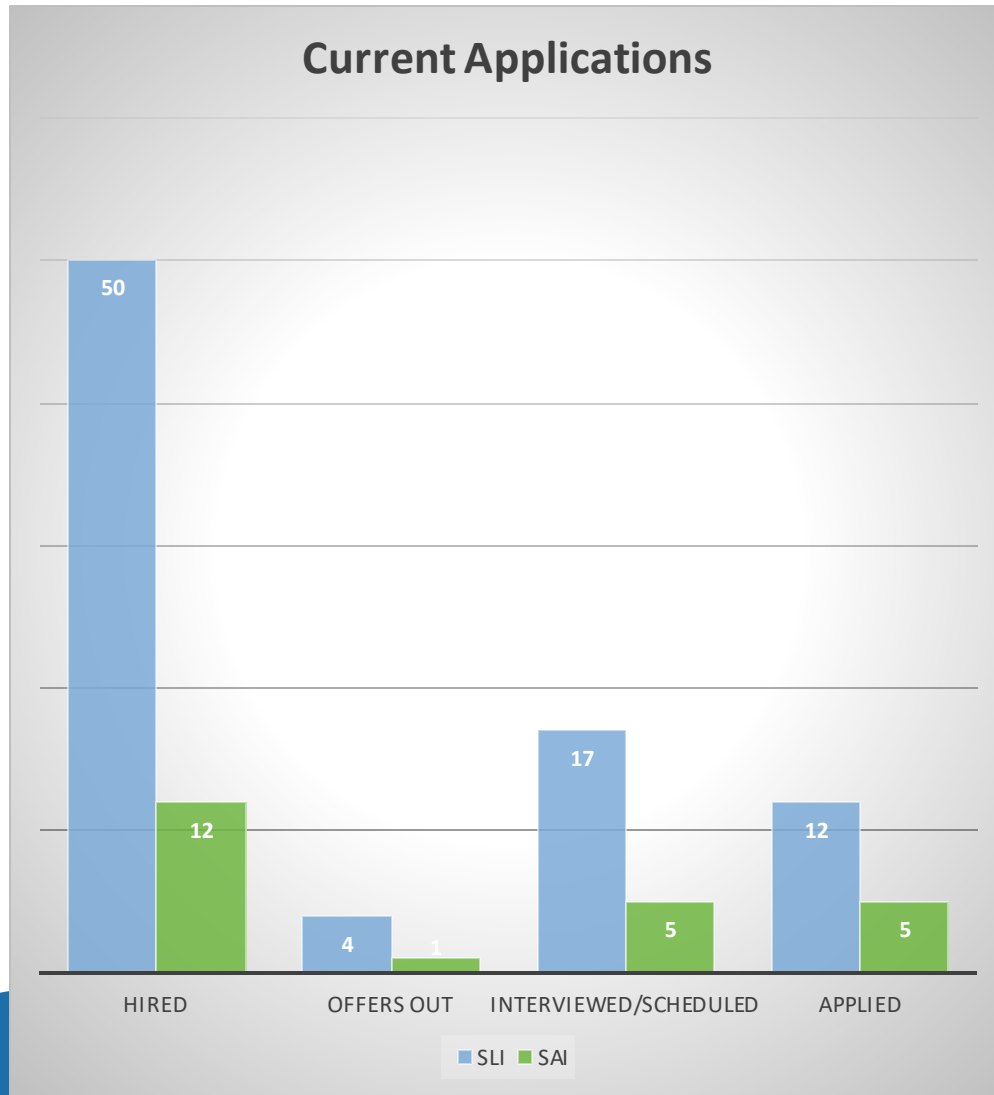

SLI Recruitment



- We have currently hired 50 SLIs and 12 SAIs for this upcoming summer.
- We need a minimum of 70 SLIs and 13 SAIs. We want to hire as many as 83 SLIs.
- We are currently ahead of where we were this time last year (we had hired 36 SLIs and 5 SAIs).



Securing Interns

- Based on the current rate of applications and interviews, we are confident we will reach the required number of SLIs and SAls for this summer.
- We are also confident that we will hire some additional SLIs to serve as floaters.

Recruitment & Training Manager

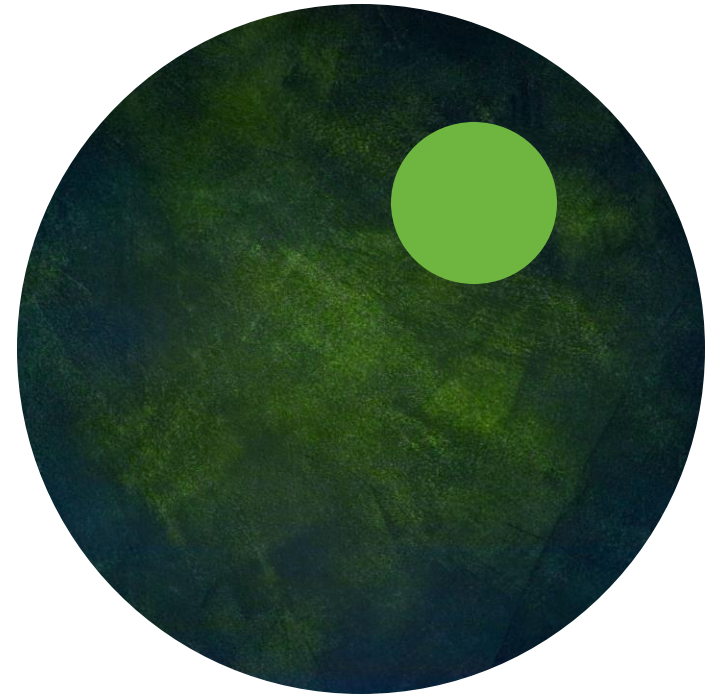
We are actively looking for candidates to fill the new full-time recruiter position.
