



Afternoon Activity Instructor Job Description

Position Overview

The Afternoon Activity Instructor is responsible for providing beginner-level lessons to groups of 10-30 scholars. The afternoon activity period for scholars is 1:00-2:30 pm. The activity must be engaging and organized.

Position Description

- Based on the activity, instructors can provide one 45-minute lesson and rotate classes, teaching 2 sessions in one afternoon, OR instructors may provide a 90-minute lesson for one group.
- Scholars are grouped into three levels. Instructors must be able to work with all levels. There may be lessons that mix Level I and II or Level II and III.
 - Level I – Grades K-2
 - Level II – Grades 3-5
 - Level III – Grades 6-8
- Instructors will be expected to teach at up to four Freedom School sites, which will be concentrated in a geographical region.
- Freedom School Partners will work with instructor to obtain necessary supplies.

Qualifications/Knowledge/Education

- Proven expertise in specific activity
- Experience teaching or instructing children in some capacity
- Desire to work with diverse groups of scholars
- Highly motivated, enthusiastic, outgoing and task oriented
- Valid ID and reliable transportation
- Satisfactory background check for criminal and child protective findings

Accountability

Shall be accountable to the Enrichment Director

Compensation

- \$60 per 90-minute lesson
