



Servant Leader Intern Job Description

Position Summary

The Servant Leader Intern (SLI) serves as a classroom teacher in a Freedom School literacy based summer enrichment program. The SLI helps to serve breakfast and lunch, leads a literacy rich curriculum during the morning, and leads/chaperones activities or field trips in the afternoon. The Servant Leader Intern should be experienced in working with groups of children, responsible, energetic, possess the ability to think on his/her feet, be a good leader and a strong role model.

Primary Duties

- Attend CDF *Freedom Schools*® National Training, and in-town training with Freedom School Partners.
- Set-up, maintain and breakdown classroom space, adhering to Freedom School's guidelines and instructions
- Serve as energetic Harambee (morning pep rally) leaders each morning of program operation
- Deliver the Integrated Reading Curriculum (IRC) to a class of ten or more scholars for the 6 weeks of the program, per the standards developed by CDF *Freedom Schools*®
- Serve as leaders of afternoon activities and other special events; chaperone field trips
- Participate in Family Engagement Nights throughout the duration of the program
- Maintain health and safety standards, and report any concerns to the Site Coordinator
- Maintain accurate attendance records
- Collaborate with site staff to establish and maintain a positive, supportive, and structured environment for the scholars
- Serve as a positive role model for the Freedom School Partners scholars

Skills Required

- Interest in working with and supervising children in a classroom setting
- Strong interpersonal skills and possess the ability to motivate others
- Able to communicate effectively, both orally and in writing
- Mature and professional demeanor
- Ability to work in the summer heat, lift at least 50 pounds and actively participate in all field trips and activities (field days, swimming, science experiments, etc.)
- Interest in working as part of an intergenerational team, with the ability to help build positive team spirit
- Enthusiasm for the CDF *Freedom Schools*® program and commitment to children's advocacy and servant leadership
- Strong appreciation for individual cultural history and the willingness to be open to, and respectful of all cultures
- At least 18 years old, enrolled in college and completed at least 1 year of undergraduate studies or recent college graduate who has previously served as a Freedom School Servant Leader Intern (SLI)
- Ability to reside near Charlotte area for duration of training and summer program (room and board/housing assistance are unavailable)
- Valid ID and reliable transportation
- Satisfactory drug test and satisfactory background check for criminal and child protective findings
