



Freedom School Remote Teacher Job Description

Position Summary

The Freedom School Remote Teacher serves as a classroom teacher in our virtual Freedom School program, a literacy based summer enrichment program. The Freedom School Remote Teacher will work with a co-teacher to lead a literacy rich curriculum during the morning, and enrichment activities in the afternoon, in a virtual setting. The Freedom School Remote Teacher should be experienced in working with groups of children, responsible, energetic, possess the ability to think on his/her feet, be a good leader and a strong role model.

Primary Duties

- Attend CDF *Freedom Schools*® National Training, and in-town training with Freedom School Partners.
- Create an online classroom, adhering to Freedom School's guidelines and instructions
- Encourage scholar participation and lead discussions to keep scholars active and engaged in learning
- Participate in virtual Harambee (morning pep rally) each morning of program operation
- Work with a co-teacher to deliver the Integrated Reading Curriculum (IRC) to a class of 20 scholars for the 6 weeks of the program, per the standards developed by CDF *Freedom Schools*®
- Facilitate afternoon enrichment activities
- Maintain accurate attendance records
- Collaborate with co-teacher to establish and maintain a positive, supportive, and structured learning environment for the scholars
- Serve as a positive role model for the Freedom School Partners scholars

Skills Required

- College graduate that has worked as a classroom teacher, preferably has taught students in a virtual setting
- Interest in working with and supervising children in a virtual setting
- Strong interpersonal skills and possess the ability to motivate scholars to learn and keep them engaged
- Able to communicate effectively, both orally and in writing
- Mature and professional demeanor
- Must possess excellent computer skills and have ability to work with multiple computer programs
- Strong leadership skills and possess the ability to maintain virtual classroom discipline and successfully guide scholars through daily lessons
- Enthusiasm for the CDF *Freedom Schools*® program and commitment to children's advocacy and servant leadership
- Strong appreciation for individual cultural history and the willingness to be open to, and respectful of all cultures
- Valid ID and reliable transportation
- Satisfactory drug test and satisfactory background check for criminal and child protective findings
